Council previously co-contributed \$39,000 per year
The Special Rate Scheme raised \$41,500 each year
The total amount raised was over \$80,000 annually

Events & Activations


Supports events such as Christmas and Easter celebrations, Mother's Day, kids activities, Halloween and more.

Provides a united voice to Banyule City Council and Government on matters that affect our precinct.




